## Boys Basketball League

### Regulations

#### 1. **LEAGUE DIRECTOR:**

Has authority to make rulings on any matter related to the Boys Basketball League.

#### 2. **PLAYER ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

Player must meet all of the following requirements. **Violation(s)** are subject to game forfeiture.

##### **DIVISION PLAY:**

- A) Age requirement is 14-18 years old. **Player's age is determined as of February 18, 2023.** i.e. **player that turns 19 PRIOR to 2/18/23 is NOT eligible to participate.**
- B) Did not participate on a High School "Varsity" school sponsored team for 10 games or more.
- C) Name listed on appropriate team roster on file with the Athletic Office.
- D) Participation on (1) team only.

##### **TOURNAMENT PLAY:**

Meet division play requirements AND participate in a **minimum** of (2) division games.

#### 3. **TEAM ROSTER REQUIREMENTS:**

**Violation(s)** are subject to game forfeiture.

- A) List names of all players participating in league play.
- B) Submit Roster to Athletic Staff at 1<sup>st</sup> game. Team rosters will be kept on file with the Athletic Office for player eligibility purposes, player additions, deletions and transfers (see below "Changes to a Team Roster").
- C) Fraudulent information (i.e. false, incorrect) is grounds for a coach/player/team to be dismissed from league play without a refund.

#### 4. **CHANGES TO TEAM ROSTER:**

- A) **ADD PLAYER;**  
Allowed anytime prior to the final (2) games of the regular season.
- B) **TRANSFER (to another team);**  
A player may transfer (1) time, during a season, and cannot re-sign with the same team.

#### 5. **ZERO TOLERANCE LEAGUE:**

**The following rules apply BEFORE, DURING and AFTER games and anywhere in the vicinity of the basketball program.**

- A) Property abuse (i.e. kicking doors, trash cans, etc), use of profane language and disrespectful behavior are not allowed and the offender(s) is subject to ejection/suspension.
- B) Any coach, player and/or spectator that is abusive toward the game official(s), Parks and Recreational staff or the opposing team shall be subject to a period of indefinite suspension at the discretion of the League Director.
- C) A coach, player or spectator who engages in a fight is subject to suspension for (1) calendar year or longer dependent upon the severity of the incident.

**6. TECHNICAL FOUL LIMITS - PLAYER/COACH/TEAM:**

**UNSPORTSMANLIKE** technical foul(s);

- A) **(2) UNSPORTSMANLIKE** technical fouls charged to a player or coach in a game will result in immediate ejection and suspension from the next game.
- B) **(3) UNSPORTSMANLIKE** technical fouls charged to a team in a game will result in immediate game forfeiture.
- C) **(4) UNSPORTSMANLIKE** technical fouls in a season, or **(2) EJECTIONS** on a player or coach will result in suspension for the remainder of the season.

**7. FORFEIT GAME:**

- A) Any team that **forfeits (2) games** is subject to removal from league play without a refund.
- B) Game forfeiture, may include the following but is not limited to;
  - 1. Unpaid team or individual registration fees.
  - 2. Unsportsmanlike conduct.
  - 3. Inability to field a team.
  - 4. Use of player who does not meet all player eligibility requirements.
  - 5. Fraudulent player information on the game scoresheet.
- C) Game score will be 11-0 in favor of the team not at fault UNLESS the point differential is higher for the non-offending team.

**8. STANDINGS TIE-BREAKERS:**

Teams with identical won-loss records at the conclusion of the regular season will use the following guidelines, in order of sequence, to break ties in the divisional standings.

- A) Best winning percentage in regular season head-to-head competition.
- B) Best point differential in regular season head-to-head competition.
- C) Share league championship title.

**9. GAME OFFICIALS:**

- A) Game officials are contracted with the PBOA (Peninsula Basketball Officials Association).
- B) Concerns with the game officials must be submitted in written format to the League Director. A copy will be kept on file with the Athletic Office and the original delivered to the PBOA President and Assignor.
